Hello Teachers,

It is time to start Reading Olympics for the 2009-2010 school year!

Here is the Reading Olympics folder. On **Friday, October 2** (when the reading logs are due), please place all logs in this folder and give it to the child of your Reading Olympics volunteer. Your volunteer should tally the reading minutes and return the folder to you or to the school office by **Wednesday, October 7**. Please place any folders returned directly to you in the Reading Olympics mailbox in the office. We will input the totals in the computer and give you the certificates denoting the minutes read, along with a coupon for a free pizza, to each child who has turned their log in on time.

Late reading logs can be placed directly in the Reading Olympics box as you receive them. These students will receive credit for their reading minutes, and if the log was returned within one week of the deadline, a certificate with pizza coupon will be issued.

For most classes, we have been given the name of the Reading Olympics volunteer, and we have written that name on the Reading Olympics folder for your class. If there is no name written on your folder, then we don't know who has volunteered for your class. Please forward the folder to the appropriate volunteer, and send us a quick email with their name and contact information. If you do NOT have a volunteer, turn your folder in to the office, and Christina or I will handle everything for September, and we will find a volunteer for you.
